

Bill and Nickey,

If posible, I think we should move to 24 hour Friday-Sunday deployments. The numbers show (last weeks data) that we will get a 50% increase if we move the weekday deployment to the weekend. What's more, the data shows that we have higher speeds for evening and early morning deployments. The stats: 575 total violations for Wednesday-Sunday. Breakdown: 100 violations for weekday, and 475 for weekend. The average violation count for weekday was 50 violations per weekday (16 hour) deployment. The average for weekend deployments was 135 violations per day (16 hour) deployment; that's excluding Nelson's 3rd shift. Nelson captured 30 violations for third shift, which was the same volume as a weekday deployment, but 40% of those violations were 85+MPH; whereas, on average, 25% of the violations were 85+ for weekday deployments.

Could we please make a decision on this ASAP, cause Dobbs has court scheduled for the 18-21. If we don't move to the 24 hour Friday-Sunday deployments this week, we will have to find a fill-in for Dobbs. Let me know your thoughts. Regards, <image001.png>

Jason,

Please take a look at the number of deployed officer hours. Our goal is to have 160 deployed hours a week and 640 deployed hours a month. In October we employed the Officers 528 hours, and, in November we employed them for 471 hours. If these numbers are good numbers, then I have a couple of concerns:

1) The trend is not good; and,

2) Our November deployed hours is about 26% lower than the 640 hours a month we subscribe to.

Please check your records to see if the Officer time sheets match these numbers; and, if not, accounting will need to be brought into the loop to make the necessary adjustments to the iTRAFFIC bill.

Let's discuss on Friday if your schedule permits. Thanks.




### # Tickets Daily to Sandy
